

Armstrong Commercial Floor Warranty

PRODUCTS

Armstrong warrants its regular (first quality) commercial sheet and tile floors, rubber stair treads and accessories, vinyl and rubber wall base, and welding rods to be free from manufacturing defects for five years from the date of purchase.

INSTALLATION

Armstrong warrants the installation integrity of its commercial floor products for five years from the date of purchase if installed according to the American Engineered Installation System, detailed in manual F-5061. The F-5061 manual is revised on a yearly basis, and floors should be installed according to the recommendations contained in the issue of F-5061 that is current and available at the time of installation.

WORKMANSHIP

Armstrong does not warrant the installers' workmanship. Workmanship errors should be addressed to the contractor who installed the floor. Your Armstrong commercial floor should be professionally installed by contractors who have demonstrated expertise in installing commercial floors. WARRANTY OWNER

This warranty extends only to the original end-user.

EXCLUSIONS

The following are some examples of problems not covered by this Warranty because they are not manufacturing defects, are the result of improper installation, or are the result of inappropriate end-user activities:

*Indentation from improper loading including high heels, spiked shoes, rolling loads, chairs or other furniture not using floor protectors.

*Discoloration.

*Failure of the floor to adhere due to, for example, moisture, alkaline or hydrostatic pressure from the subfloor

TERMS

Within One Year: If a covered defect is reported to Armstrong in writing within one year of purchase, Armstrong will supply new products of the same or similar grade sufficient to repair or replace the defective materials. Armstrong will also pay the reasonable labor costs involved in repairing or replacing the defective material.

Within Two Years: If a covered defect is reported to Armstrong in writing within the second year of purchase, Armstrong will supply new products of the same or similar grade sufficient to repair or replace the defective materials. Armstrong will also pay fifty percent of the reasonable labor costs involved.

After Two Years: If a covered defect is reported to Armstrong in writing after two years but within five years of purchase, Armstrong will supply new products of the same or similar grade sufficient to repair or replace the defective materials. Armstrong will not pay labor costs to repair or replace material after two years.

Armstrong will not pay labor costs to repair or replace materials with visual defects that were apparent before installation.

These are the only remedies available for breach for the Warranty.

Armstrong disclaims any liability for differences in color between products and samples or photographs.

All other warranties, including warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, are excluded.

ARMSTRONG EXCLUDES ANY LIABILITY FOR LOST PROFITS OR ANY OTHER INDIRECT, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES RESULTING FROM DEFECTIVE FLOORING MATERIALS.
